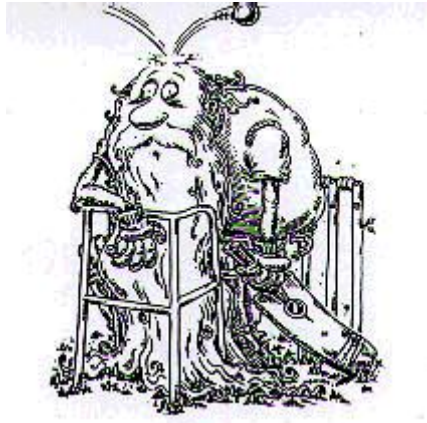

## TEAM LISTS APPEAR LATER

With so many new faces in our teams, I thought, it, opportune to document some basic information concerning the conduct of fixtured matches.

- An equipment kit is available for those not possessing personal gear.
- All matches commence at 1.00pm unless otherwise arranged between competing teams.
- Please be at the match venue by 12.30pm to greet the opposition.
- Members of the home team are required to:
  - Erect stumps and sweep the pitch (as necessary)
  - Place cones for boundary near practice pitches.
  - Ensure table/chairs available for scorers.
  - Place scoreboard in position visible from centre wicket.

- Prepare afternoon tea, to be available during change of innings. Tea, coffee facilities provided by club.
  - NB All member of home team to provide a plate (eg sandwiches, cakes, biscuits, fruit etc.) Clean up afterwards.
  - At completion of the match, return stumps, bails, broom, scoreboard and cones to change rooms.
- Socialise with opposition after the game.- Home team will be required to cook sausages for a snack after the match. To be served, in bread, free to all.
  - A local bistro/restaurant will be selected for an after match venue for members of both Warrandyte teams to meet with partners and families, for a meal, drink and discussion of the feats of the day. – Alternatively a BBQ will be organised at the ground.
