Steve and Bob top season averages

Steve Pascoe and Bob McDonald were the season's stars for Warrandyte Cricket Club's premier A-grade team.

Pascoe won the batting trophy with an average of 57.57.

Leg-spinner McDonald took the bowling award with the remarkable average of 9.8.

Trophies were presented at the club's wind-up at the Mullum Social Club rooms on March 29.

The 1979-80 cricket will go down as "Warrandyte's year".

Warrandyte Cricket Club's 125th anniversary year was also one of the most successful in their history.

The Dytes fielded 10 teams in the Ringwood District competition and brought home five premierships — including the A-grade.

After setting the pace all season, the A-graders beat Ainslie Park by 10 wickets in the grand final.

The other premierships winners are the A-Reserves, E-grade and the two Under-12 teams.

Quite apart from the A-grade success, the club are delighted with the Under-12's performance.

"It is a tribute to the time and work that has gone into junior cricket in this town," club president Geoff Day told the Diary.

"More particularly, it is a tribute to Bruce Kline, our junior administrator."

Warrandyte set up the A-grade final victory by dismissing Ainslie Park by 124 in the first innings.

Fred Jungwirth took the bowling honours, with 4-39.

The Dytes were in trouble themselves at 9-165 in reply, but captain Stan Davis and Max Summers hit them into a winning

position with a last-wicket stand of 83.

Warrandyte led by 124 on the first innings and were left to score only 88 for victory when Ainslie Park made 9/211 in their second visit to the crease.

Steve Pascoe returned the best bowling figures, 4-79.

The Dytes made the runs without loss, openers Richard Bowen and John Chapman scoring 43 and 40 respectively.

The A-reserve grand final was a much closer affair, with Warrandyte getting home by just five runs from Heathmont United.

Brian Chapman top-scored for Warrandyte, with 74.

The E-grade were never in danger against Norwood and won by seven wickets.

The Under-12 teams both scored resounding victories, by 107 and 137 runs respectively.
