

Land for Warrandyte Reserve had been set aside as a cricket ground as early as 1855, making Warrandyte one of the oldest cricket grounds in Victoria and Australia. In 1865, the ground was officially set aside as recreation land by the Government; this saved it from gold mining claims following protests from residents. Although games are known to have been played earlier, the first documented match was played on the 1st Jan 1864. The first basic facilities, shelter and fencing were installed 1908. Facilities evolved gradually to more formal clubrooms, but were destroyed in 1939 during the Black Friday bushfires. A new pavilion was eventually built, where it stands to this day. Extensions were completed in 1988 which give us the social rooms that stand today.

DUTIES OF CAPTAINS

Team Captains are responsible for ensuring that:

1. Conduct of team members is exemplary.
2. Their team displays high sportsmanship and abides by the Spirit of Cricket.
3. If playing at home that the ground is in order, flags (if required) are in the correct position and stumps are in position at least 5 minutes before the start of play on each day.
4. Their team is ready to play at the scheduled time.
5. A competent scorer is available.
6. Before the start of play, captains will exchange a list of players, who may not be changed without consent of the opposing captain. These names are to be entered in the scorebook by the end of the tea interval on the first day.
7. At the end of a match, in which professional umpires officiate, complete a "Captain's Report on Umpires" form. It is optional to complete this form for games where there are no professional umpires.
8. Both scorebooks are correct at the end of each innings and at the conclusion of each day's play. Sign the opposing team's scorebook at the end of the day's play.
9. Officially appointed umpires are paid at the afternoon tea interval:
80 Over games, 2 umpires: \$90 a day (each), 1 umpire: \$110 a day. 70 over games, 1 umpire: \$90 a day.
10. They have a good knowledge and understanding of the rules and laws of cricket and the rules of the Association.

AFTERNOON TEA

- (1) In multi-day matches, should an innings terminate or there be a suspension in play resulting from bad light or weather conditions within 15 minutes of the scheduled tea break, an adjournment will be taken immediately and, upon resumption, play shall continue under the normal playing conditions.
- (2) Should the team batting have lost 9 wickets at the time scheduled for the afternoon tea break, play may continue for up to 15 minutes in an endeavour to complete the innings.
- (3) Drinks may be taken if pre-arranged before each session between captains and umpires.

PENALTIES FOR SLOW OVER RATE

Two Day Matches

A penalty of 0.2 bonus points per over will be applied to every over commenced after 6.00pm, plus time allowed for extenuating circumstances. The rule shall cease to apply (for that day) if the team batting in its first innings is dismissed or declares prior to 5.00pm. If the team is dismissed between 5.00pm and 6.00pm the following number of overs will apply: 5pm-62, 5.30pm-71. Umpires must advise the bowling side captain the status of overs bowled at each scheduled break of play.

Limited Overs Matches

Where allowances have been made for delays, the completion time shall be extended by the minutes involved. If the side bowling first or second fails to complete the designated overs by the due time, it will be penalised 0.2 bonus points per over bowled after due time an over in progress shall be regarded as a completed over.

RDCA Heat Policy

Should the forecast (at 11am on the day of play) be for a maximum of more than 40 degrees, then ALL scheduled matches will be abandoned for the day. Confirmation of such a decision will be sent to club contacts by SMS and also be available on the RDCA telephone (9876 7206) by 12 noon). Where play proceeds, on a day where the temperature may reach more than 40 degrees, the Umpires or captains (lower grades) are to telephone 9669 4916 prior to commencement of play and then at the scheduled breaks in play (drinks and tea) to check current temperature. Should it be "more than 40 degrees" (ie 40.1 or more) then play is to be suspended until the temperature drops to 40 degrees or less. Umpires and lower grade captains (by agreement) are empowered to terminate play for the day in the interests of participant welfare. Where there is a desire to continue, the temperature should be monitored half hourly and play can only recommence when it has dropped to 40 degrees or less. Breaks in play must be recorded in both scorebooks. Note! There will be no reduction in overs for adverse weather. Play may continue to 7pm to make up for lost time.

Adverse Weather

In the event of active thunderstorm activity in the immediate vicinity of the playing area, all play is to cease immediately and all players, umpires and officials are to find safe shelter without delay.



MAJOR RULE CHANGES

- Rule 64 (a) – “Drawn” games will result in each team receiving 4 points plus any bonus points earned
- Rule 65 – under the new structure, the basic principle, where possible, is that Premiers will be promoted and last placed teams relegated.
- Rule 84 (8) – Bowling restrictions – U17 players are restricted to 16 overs per day, U19 bowlers to 20 overs per day. Note! These thresholds include overs bowled in junior competition. Onus is on the captains to control this aspect and any breaches will be referred to Operations/Investigation committee for action, as appropriate.
- Rule 94 c – Failure to lodge a “Captains Appraisal on Professional Umpire” form will initially result in a captain receiving a warning of non-compliance. Any further failure to comply will result in the captain receiving a “naming” for each instance thereafter.



Traditionally, cricket has been the one sport to maintain and exhibit the highest levels of conduct and sportsmanship. While always a most competitive game, the continued strength of the sport has relied upon the acceptance of the Umpire's decision and the preparedness to play within the "spirit of the game". The areas of major concern and those clearly unacceptable, are:

1. The use of offensive language - generally as a disparaging remark to an opposing player or toward an Umpire, or even as an expression of frustration or self-admonishment. This includes racial vilification (any act that is reasonably likely to threaten, disparage, vilify, offend, insult, humiliate or intimidate another person or group based on race, religion, descent, colour or national or ethnic origin). This applies equally to dismissals and unsuccessful appeals as to the judgment of calls on no-balls, wides, byes, etc.
2. The questioning/disputing of the Umpire's decision - often in an aggressive or sarcastic manner. This applies equally to dismissals and unsuccessful appeals as to the judgment of calls on no-balls, wides, byes, etc.
3. The excessive number of frivolous and ridiculous appeals - primarily aimed at pressuring and intimidating the Umpire into a favourable decision.
4. The actions of the dismissed batsman - in failing to leave the crease promptly on being given out and any equipment abuse (eg banging the bat into the ground or against the fence or race, etc and/or throwing the bat or equipment during or after his return to the pavilion).
5. "send offs" - usually to a dismissed batsman by the bowler or a member of the fielding side. This can often inflame the situation and lead to a more serious altercation.

Players must at all times abide by the Code of Conduct of the Ringwood District Cricket Association:

- (1) The following code of behaviour has been recommended by the Victorian Metropolitan Cricket Union (VMCU) for inclusion in local rules books.
- (2) All matches shall be conducted in the true spirit of the game of cricket and club Officials, Coaches, Captains and Players are requested to adopt this code.
- (3) No player or official shall, during any match, whether on or off the field of play, engage in conduct unbecoming to the game of cricket.

Players shall:

- (a) Respect the umpire.
- (b) Not verbally or physically abuse any umpire.
- (c) Not dispute the umpire's decision nor react in a threatening or disapproving manner.
- (d) When given out, move immediately from the field.
- (e) Generally assist the umpire in carrying out his duties.
- (f) Not indulge in "sledging" of opposition players.
- (g) Not verbally or physically abuse opposition players or officials.

- (4) Clubs shall place all teams under the control of a responsible person.

Captains shall:

- (a) Instruct all players to avoid time wasting. Incoming and outgoing batsmen are expected to pass on the field of play.
- (b) Instruct all players to be ready to the start of the run-up period and be ready to bowl without time wasting.
- (c) Instruct all fieldsmen to move quickly between overs and whenever required to change position, ie field setting/changes be undertaken without time wasting.
- (d) Ensure that players conduct themselves in a manner that conforms to the traditional image of the game of cricket.
- (e) No alcohol shall be consumed by players or match officials during the hours of play.
- (7) Players shall maintain a standard of dress:
- (a) All players must appear on the field in proper cricket attire, comprising white shirt with collar, white pullover if worn, long white trousers, white socks and white footwear which may include coloured stripes. Players officiating as umpires must wear proper cricket attire plus distinguishing clothing as required under Rule 113. White shorts may be worn only by players under the age of sixteen (16) years, on the 1st September each year. Umpires shall report players contravening this rule who shall, on a first occasion, be fined \$3.00 and, if a further breach of this rule occurs, shall be dealt with by the Board of Management, which may impose a higher fine or penalty.
- (b) No player shall wear boots or shoes equipped with studs, spikes, springs or projections made of metal or hard plastic which could damage the surface when playing on matting or synthetic wickets. The penalty for non-compliance with this rule shall be a fine of \$12.00 and the offending player shall not be permitted to participate in the match until this rule has been complied with.
- (c) No alcohol shall be consumed for the behaviour of their supporters and spectators.
- (9) Player being NAMED Under the following criteria:
- (a) During the progress of a match, all players and club officials shall behave in an orderly and seemly manner and abide by the spirit of cricket.
- (b) Bad language will not be tolerated. Smoking on the playing field during the progress of a match is strictly prohibited. Alcoholic beverages must not be consumed during hours of play.
- (c) Clubs will be responsible for the behaviour of their spectators.
- (c) Where an umpire believes a player has infringed the code or conduct, but does not believe a formal report is warranted, the umpire shall inform the player that he will be named. At the same time, the umpire will advise the Team Captain of the naming and that any further such incidents during that match will result in the Captain being named for inability to control his players. The naming will be formalised by completion of a "Naming Form", which is to be signed by the offending player and/or his captain and/or club representative. After each naming the player and the club secretary shall be notified in writing. Should a player be named on two occasions over a season, the player shall be automatically suspended for the next 2 RDCA matches in which the player's team is competing. Subsequent namings will be dealt with as seen fit by the Board of Management.
- (d) Should a player be named in the finals series, such naming shall carry over to the subsequent season.
- (e) Umpires are to report serious breaches of behavior
- (f) It is expected that misconduct by a player or club official shall, in the first instance, bear the following minimum penalties.

Disputing decision	Naming
Sledging	Naming
Alcohol consumption during match times (player)	Report 4 weeks
Equipment Abuse	Report 4 weeks
Abusive language – to player	Report 4 weeks
Abusive language – to Umpire	Report 8 weeks
Intentional player contact	Report 12 weeks (min)
Umpire intimidation	Report Investigation
Other misconduct	Report Investigation

If the misconduct recurs these penalties may escalate.

Manager Administration may nominate an appropriate penalty that a reported player may accept in lieu of attending an Investigation Committee hearing.

(g) Any player suspended during the season shall be deemed ineligible for selection in representative teams.

(h) Penalties, whether automatically accepted or imposed at a hearing, shall be posted on RDCA website.

The Warrandyte Cricket Club requires its members to behave in a manner that respects other members, protects their safety and welfare, and that of the property, grounds, equipment and facilities of the club. Failure to abide by these rules may result disciplinary action being taken that may include suspension or expulsion from the club, or other action as deemed fit by the committee.

Many players not taking part in the final came down on Tuesday and Thursday to help out the team in their preparation - this was a gesture much appreciated by the 3rd XI. For many, the nerves were already abounding; a close win the week before had done something to relieve the tension, but by Thursday night, the occasion was starting to hit home. In the final stages of training, Captain Greg Creber took his players aside on the far side of the ground, and gave a few words of experience. "Don't lie awake at night wondering what will be, and play the game in your head."

The final was an unknown quantity for many of the players. Most had had exposure to finals before at junior levels, but for many a senior grand final was a new experience. Of the team, only Luke Revell had played in a winning senior grand final at Warrandyte - coincidentally, the 1995/96 final was the last senior premiership that Warrandyte had brought home. It was a 10 season drought for the club which this team hoped to break.

The neutral venue for the final was Wonga Park reserve. Given it had been 5 years since Warrandyte had played in the Chandler Shield competition, in of it. In fact, of the playing group only Greg Creber, Nathan Croft, Daniel Wellesley and Stuart Smead had played a senior game there in a senior XI.

Come the 25th of March 2006, players trickled into the car park of a perfect Saturday midday, where to base the team in a good position to be near spectators but also provide some buffer from the opposition and their supporters. The

Warrandyte support unit was already in full swing by twelve o'clock; club members who had provided such staunch support in the preliminary final had up a large shade tent, bbq and several eskies to supply the practice nets provided a shady aspect to the ground and separate parking area, which was appreciated by all.

Once the players had established themselves, a few nervous cigarettes were had, and it was onto the ground for an energetic yet tense warm-up. The team had not made extensive efforts to refine their warm-ups to be polished and professional throughout the year, so the usual clumsiness surfaced early. Rather than demand perfection in the lead up to such a big game, Creber simply and calmly requested that his players warm-up in a responsible fashion; to take it seriously and get something out of it. He clearly did not want to increase blood pressures early, but rather save the intensity for the toss was won by Warrandyte, who sent South Warrandyte in to bat. 
