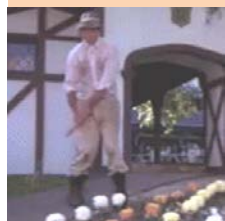

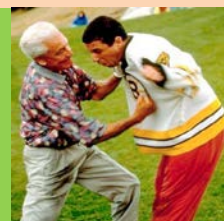

CRICKET CLUB CELEBRATES CENTENARY

Clive Fairburn, captain of Melbourne, led a strong V.C.A. team against Warrandyte on Sunday, January 1, when the Warrandyte Cricket Club celebrated its centenary. A crowd of over 2,000 gave the V.C.A. team a rousing welcome when they arrived at the ground in the century year old Cobb and Co. Coach. The coach was driven from Melbourne specifically for the occasion. The hill and pavilion an attractive sight as several beach umbrellas mingled with streamers and flags. The match was played in a picnic atmosphere and was thoroughly enjoyed by both players and spectators. After winning the toss the visitors sent Warrandyte into bat. Terry Leheny, a 17 year-old batsman, twice hooked Fairbairn over the square leg boundary for six in a score of 27. Jack Iverson, who took 4/22 off six overs, had the Warrandyte batsmen on their toes throughout the innings of 10/88. The V.C.A. team began badly when they lost Colin McDonald, Stevens and Maddocks for five runs. Huntington and Bill Ponsford brought the total to 36 before Huntington was caught by Doug Fry off the bowling of his brother Brian. Ponsford was bowled for 31. The V.C.A. innings was declared at 7/102, with Lindsay Kline on 2. At the suggestion of Cr. W. F. Hetton, the visitors sportingly took the field for a match against the Warrandyte Seconds, who scored 42. G. Dove, captain, top scored with 11.

Distinguished visitors included the Hon. G. O. Reid, M.I.A., and the Hon. R. Rawson, Cr. R. Hubbard Mayor of Ringwood, Cr. W.P. Betton, P. Vergers and K. McKenzie, and the club president Mr. J. McAuley, and secretary Mr. Stan Craker. In reply to an address of welcome by Cr. Betton, Mr. Reid congratulated the club on attaining its 100th year of activity. Mr. Reid stated that the occasion was truly a remarkable one for the district which would be remembered for a long time to come. On the conclusion of the match the visitors were entertained by Mr J. Newman. The state fast bowler John Power, expressed the sentiments of the visitors and all concerned in a well turned speech and expressed the hope that it could become an annual event.

In the match played at Warrandyte the scoring was low. Warrandyte, 1st innings, 34 C. Sanford 16 (not out) was the only batsman to reach double figures. 2nd innings 66, Wyatt and Forden, with 11 and 12 respectively, were the top scorers. Christmas Hills, 1st innings (batting one man short) 21; J. Kennedy being top scorer with 9. 2nd innings, 80 runs to win and all to bat. In bowling J. Till (for Warrandyte) did great execution, getting 6 wickets for 5 runs. At one stage he had 3 wickets for no runs and later 5 wickets for 2 runs. Hodgson, 1 for 12, was the other bowler. A. Hubbard (for Christmas Hills) was also deadly, and like Till started with 3 wickets for no runs. He finished the day with 11 for 33. J. Hubbard 4 for 15 and C. Cumberland 4 for 32 were the only other successful bowlers.

The following Saturday a change "came over the scene," as Christmas Hills, requiring 80 with an innings to go, secured the win with four wickets to spare. The visitors each day were treated to a nice luncheon by the ladies.

ANDERSON'S CREEK CRICKET CLUB

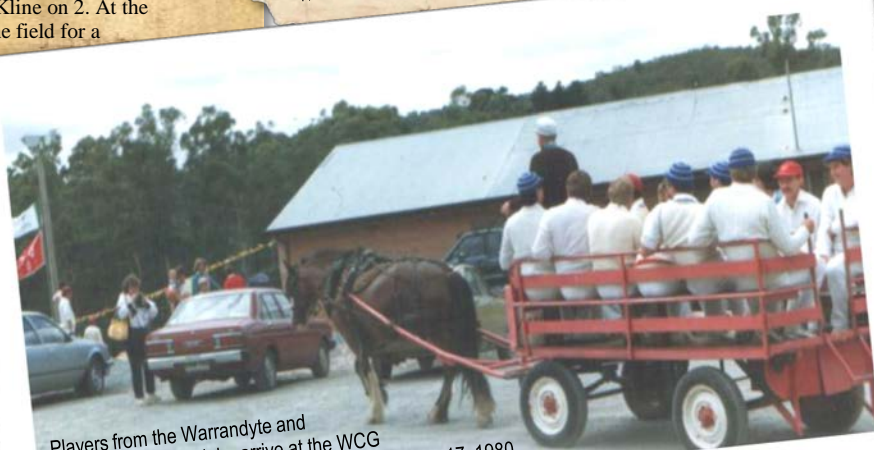

150th ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATIONS

On February 13, 2005, celebrations were completed with a special match against an Invitational XI that included former Victorian state cricketers, AFL footballers and media personalities. "We won the match but the important thing was seeing so many people attend and take part in what was a truly memorable day," said Warrandyte president Robert White. Apart from the invitational game, a 20-20 match made up of a mixture of senior and junior players was organised as a curtain raiser. The invitational game was similar to the match played in 1955 when Warrandyte celebrated their centenary with a game against a Melbourne Cricket Club XI. The highlight of the day was the introduction to the large crowd who gathered for afternoon tea of six of the men who played for Warrandyte in that game 50 years ago, Colin and Doug Chapman, Jim Harris, Geoff Day and Doug and Brian Fry. While two Melbourne players from the centenary game also attended, Colin McDonald, who was to go on and play Test cricket for Australia, and Ian Huntington, who was to later captain the Melbourne District side. "It was wonderful to have these men come along and be part of our special day," said White. "Warrandyte Cricket club have a long and proud tradition and it is important for the players of today to reflect on the efforts and deeds of some of the pioneers."

**1. JOHN (JACK) MOORE**

Inducted in 1929, John was the club's first Life Member. The award was made for his outstanding ability as a player, administrator and supporter of local cricket.

**2. HORRIE SMITH JNR**

Horrie Smith lived in Warrandyte all of his life, growing up on an orchard. He was a tough competitor and played all of his cricket as a wicketkeeper. He was still playing when he died aged 64.

**3. JACK McAULEY**

Inducted in 1959, Jack started playing before WWII. He opened the batting but was best known for his leg break bowling. The 1st XI Club Championship is named in his honour. His career spanned an phenomenal 47 years from 1921 to 1968.

**4. ALLAN CHAPMAN**

Widely regarded as one of the best players in the club's history. An opening bowler and batsman he was a long time captain of the club and also served on the committee and as president. He also coached the women's team.

**5. LES ADAMS**

An all-round cricketer and long serving administrator. Les had the vision of forming the club's junior section in 1957. A committee member and president, he was widely recognised as an outstanding leg spin bowler.

**6. JOHN CHAPMAN**

Started as a junior in 1959 and developed into one of the club's best opening batsmen and wicketkeepers. John has been president, secretary and treasurer of the club as well as junior team manager.

**7. ALAN BELLINGER**

Inducted in 1983, Alan started in Warrandyte's U16 team in 1959 and was the first junior player to serve on the committee. He was a committee member for 20 years and was also president. Alan is a premiership captain.

**8. GEOFF DAY**

Inducted in 1983, Geoff enjoyed a lengthy playing career commencing in the 1950s. A strong supporter of the club since his retirement, especially at junior level, he served as a committee member and is a former president.

**9. STEPHEN PEAKE**

Inducted in 1983, Steve was a member of the club's first junior premiership team. He coached junior teams and won five 2nd XI bowling awards. A 2nd XI captain and committee member, he won an A Grade and Chandler Shield premiership.

**10. JOHN MCCARTIN**

A junior player who first played seniors in 1971/72. He was a former committee member and chairman of selectors, and captained the 1979/80 2nd XI Premiership side. He is the only life member of both Warrandyte cricket and football clubs.

**11. MARIA MCGHEE**

Inducted in 1990, was a founding member of the women's team in 1975, she also coached the women's team, was a committee member, treasurer and secretary and was the VWCA delegate. The trophy for best junior cricketer in seniors is named in her honour.

**12. STEVE PASCOE**

Was appointed the club's first official coach in 1977. Since then he has held countless positions including president, secretary and treasurer. He was a member of a record five senior premiership sides. Former president, secretary and a life member of the RDCA.

**13. JOE SCICLUNA**

A hard working committee member, grounds manager and bar manager over many years. A strong supporter of Warrandyte's junior cricket. Played in grades from the 2nd XI to the 5th XI over 70 matches since his first game in 1978/79.

**14. JENNY CHAPMAN**

A member of the first women's team in 1975. Jenny was an outstanding all-rounder, and also kept wickets. She captained the women's team and played in both of their premierships, was a committee member and long time manager of the club's business directory.

**15. JENNI CHAPMAN**

(nee McLaws) A founding member of the club's first women's team, she was a dual premiership player and was captain of the 1991/92 premiership team. A committee member for 12 years including as treasurer.

**16. ANN PASCOE**

Ann commenced as official 1st XI scorer in 1977 and has to date kept score in over 400 1st XI matches. A former club secretary and treasurer, Ann's long association with the club continues today.

**17. GEOFF TAYLOR**

Inducted in 1994, a former committee member and president. Played in all grades since 1977. Was a strong supporter of junior cricket coaching and managing a number of teams. Geoff has returned to the committee where his son, Ben, is currently president.

**18. MARK DAVIS**

Inducted in 1995, a product of the club's junior teams, Mark first played seniors in 1966/67. He played in the A Grade premiership in 1979/80 and the Chandler Shield flag in 1981/82. His long committee service included three years as president.

**19. BRIAN CHAPMAN**

Inducted in 1996, Brian started with the club's under 12's in 1971. Injuries shortened his playing career as a top order batsman and medium pace bowler. Brian coached the Women's XI and was also a senior coach. Former committee member and selector.

**20. JIM GATHERCOLE**

Inducted in 1996, Jimmy first played in 1977/78 and became a prolific runscore in the club's lower grades playing in the 1984/85 4th XI premiership. A strong supporter of junior cricketers he was also a committee member. Enjoyed many a hand of poker after training.

**21. BRETT KLINE**

Inducted in 1998. Starting as a junior in 1977, has been a member of four premiership sides from Under 14 to Chandler Shield, captaining the 2nd XI to a flag in 1990/91. Served for 14 years on the committee, and has played the most senior games.

**22. PETER BAKER**

Long time supporter and behind-the-scenes worker at the club. Peter was a strong supporter of the junior grades where he was a manager/coach. Peter also served as a committee member and dished up many a snag on the BBQ.

**23. ROBERT WHITE**

Joined as a player in 1970/71, one of the finest cricketers ever to play for Warrandyte. Long time president and committee member, with a host of individual honours including multiple club champion and a record eight 1st XI batting awards.

**24. GERALD WALSH**

Inducted in 2004, making his senior debut aged 16 in 1979, 'Pup' is one of the most decorated cricketers at Warrandyte, and holds the club record for wickets taken. Multiple club champion and bowling award winner, and former 1st XI captain.

**25. GREG CREBER**

Inducted in 2004, a junior player at Warrandyte, he played his first senior game in 1982/83, and has captained a number of grades. A long time committee member, president and junior coach. Greg is still a tireless worker on and off the field.

**26. GRAHAM LAWRENCE**

Graham's involvement with the club stretches back to the mid 1970's, and was involved with the junior club. Over the years Graham's dedication to the club has not waned, and he is a regular supporter at matches to this day, as well as playing for the veterans.

**27. DAVID MOONEY**

Inducted in 2008. In a distinguished career stretching back to 1990, Dave has provided the club with on and off field leadership as a long serving member of the committee and former 1st XI captain. He holds the record of highest score ever in the 1st XI.

**28. STEPHEN GODDARD**

Inducted in 2011, a 200+ game veteran since joining the club in 1991. But Mystery's best work has been done off field. His dedication to the statistics, honourboards and website, as well as serving as a long time committee member has earned him the highest honour.
